Corporal Morgan is the epitome of commitment and dedication. For years, he worked without complaints while suffering from a kidney disease. Corporal Morgan served in a variety of roles during this time to include the Emergency Response Team, which is one of the most physically-demanding jobs in the jail. Many of his day-to-day coworkers didn't even know he was suffering from such a debilitating disease.

Last year, doctors determined that a kidney transplant was needed because Corporal Morgan's condition was worsening. This led to Corporal Morgan and his older brother, Josh Morgan, a former NFL wide receiver for the Washington Football Team, laying on a pair of operating tables at Med Star Georgetown Transplant Institute. The surgery and recovery were successful. Corporal Morgan has now returned to full duty.

He is a walking example of determination and grit. He is truly an asset to the Department of Corrections. For these reasons and many more, Corporal Morgan is the Department's 2021 Officer of the Year.
